Since 1994, Dr. Marsiglia has been a member of the faculty of the Arizona State University School of Social Work where he is the Distinguished Foundation Professor of Cultural Diversity and Health. He is the director of the Southwest Interdisciplinary Research Center (SIRC), a national exploratory center of excellence funded by the National Center on Minority Health and Health Disparities (NCMHD), National Institutes of Health (NIH). In addition, Dr. Marsiglia is the Principal Investigator of other NIH and CDC funded intervention research projects studying risk and protective factors associated with health outcomes among Mexican/Mexican American and Native American youth and their families in the Southwest region.
